Multiplication Check

Year 4 will be completing their Multiplication Check starting the first week after half term.

This assessment tests the children’s speed and accuracy when recalling multiplication facts from the 2 to 12 times tables, with only 6 seconds allowed for each question.

To help support each child’s individual needs, I will be sending home personalised multiplication booklets for extra practice.

EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS

Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning.

Attendance	Absence & Learning Missed
100%	No days missed
95%	9 days absent — 1 week and 4 days missed
90%	19 days absent — 3 weeks and 4 days missed
85%	28 days absent — 5 weeks and 3 days missed

Missing just ONE day each week means a child is missing 20% of their education.

This can make it difficult to keep up with classwork, maintain friendships and develop essential life skills.
